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College Application and Essay Prep Course (DAY) July 14, 16, 21, 23, 28 & Aug. 1 2 to 5 PM \$149	Grade 12. College Application and Essay Prep Course (EVENING) July 14, 16, 21, 23, 28 & Aug. 1 6 to 9 PM \$149	Grade 12. This is a six-day summer program designed to help rising seniors complete the college application process, specifically, the Common App. Students who attend all classes will start senior year with their college essays and applications completed. August 1 <sup>st</sup> class will be from 9 AM to Noon (dates subject to change). Note: This course has SOLD OUT each of the last three summers!
Creative Writing July 13-16 9 AM to Noon \$99	Grades 6-9. Students will focus on creative writing. Topics will include, but may not be limited to, the composition of poems, short stories, and other creative genres. SAT Math Prep Aug. 11, 13, 18, 20 5-8 p.m. \$125	Grades 11-12. This course is designed to prepare students for the math sections on the SAT. Students will examine and practice the frameworks tested on the mathematics SAT test: Pre-Algebra through Trigonometry. Students will be required to have College Board/Khan Academy accounts.
Theater Arts Camp July 13-16 Noon to 3 PM \$99	Grades 6-9. Students will participate in activities to introduce and improve upon performing art skills. Activities may include, but are not limited to, familiarity with relevant terms, tips for learning dialogue, improvisation to practice acting skills, different ways to convey voice projection and body language, and understanding what it means to be a member of a theater arts production.
