As long as a student meets the MCC requirements and Shawsheen's requirements, then the student is allowed to take the class without enrolling in MCC course.




COURSE CHANGES

The course-selection process that takes place each spring is conducted with great care and with input from teachers and guidance counselors. CHOOSE YOUR CLASSES WISELY.



Course changes are disruptive to the continuity of a student's educational program and the master schedule.



All course change requests must occur prior to the end of the school year.

Extremely limited course change requests can be submitted within the first two weeks of school. After this time, no other requests will be granted except in extraordinary circumstances which will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
