Class of 2025 – Here We Go!

- Graduation is 2 months and 8 days away.
- Senior Sign-Out is 2 months and 2 days away.
 - 20 academic days remaining (including today)
 - 19 shop/co-op days remaining
- Finish the year strong, make the most of the time remaining, and make good choices so you remain eligible for prom, graduation, and senior activities!



Eligibility Requirements

- Students must meet all eligibility requirements to participate in senior activities (including prom):
 - Academic: must be passing at least 35 credits worth of classes for Q3.
 - Attendance: must have less than 7 unexcused absences in Q3.
 - Can't have two quarters with 5 or more unexcused absences.
 - Detentions: if you hit 15 detentions, must reduce to 8 to become eligible.
- Note: prom dates can only attend prom if they also meet eligibility requirements. Must be under 21.



Make Good Choices!

- School rules are in place for seniors until graduation, and at all school-sponsored events.
- Consequences for breaking rules can result in not being able to attend prom, graduation, or senior activities – we do NOT want that to happen for any of you!
- Words of Caution:
 - Senior pranks never end well and can cost students & families money for damages caused.
 - Drug & alcohol violations apply at school and all school events (including prom).

May 28 – Cap/Gown & Yearbook Distribution + Laptop Return

- At assigned times during Related on Wednesday, May 28, seniors will be called down to:
 - Return their school laptops
 - Laptops will be re-configured and returned to seniors during Class Day on Monday, June 2 (if Tech Insurance Fees were paid)
 - Receive their Cap & Gown Packages
 - Receive their Yearbooks (if ordered)



May 30 - Senior Prom

- Friday, May 30, 2025 from 6pm – 10pm at Seaglass in Salisbury, MA.
- \$80/ticket – on sale April 7 – May 16 in school store during lunch.
- Tickets, guest forms, and early dismissal forms available in school store.
- Professional photo information emailed by Smile Pro.
- Must attend at least a half day of school/co-op (same for guests).
 - Billerica Elementary School Breakfast for Seniors at 9am – dismissals approved.
- No large bags – any bags subject to search.
- No re-entry if you leave early.



Friday, May 30 = Senior Sign Out

- Last day of school for eligible seniors.
- See item 5 on the handout for the full list of eligibility requirements to sign out on May 30.
 - Passing with 35+ credits for the year
 - Including English, shop, related, PE/Health, & graduation requirements
 - Shop hours & co-op time-cards completed
 - Return laptop charger & bag (May 28 - as assigned)
 - Receive cap & gown (May 28 – as assigned)
 - Receive yearbook (May 28 – as assigned)
 - Return all books, materials, & tools
 - Serve all outstanding detentions



Monday, June 2 = Senior Breakfast, Vocational Awards, & Graduation Rehearsal

- Attendance is **mandatory** for graduation rehearsal – we want everyone to look great and know where to go on graduation day!
- Breakfast will be served in the cafeteria (arrive by 8:30am, and as early as 8am)
- Following breakfast, Vocational Awards and Graduation Rehearsal will be held in the gym
- Graduation Tickets will be distributed at Graduation Rehearsal
 - 6 if outdoors
 - 2 if indoors



Thursday, June 5 at 6pm = Graduation!

- Seniors report to their assigned rooms at 5pm (we will review this during graduation rehearsal on June 3).
- Rain Date = Friday, June 6
 - Option 1: outdoor graduation at Shawsheen
 - Option 2: (due to weather) indoors at Burlington High School (strict 2 guest limit per graduate)

- Start time = 10pm on Thursday, June 5
- End time = 5:30am on Friday, June 6
- FREE Event hosted by the PAC – sign-up will be required (with Ms. Ferrari at the end of May).
- Highlights include: Food and beverages throughout the evening and donuts in the morning, DJ, Video Gaming Truck, Inflatables, Selfie Station, Hypnotist, Caricature Artists, Henna & Airbrush Tattoos, Angel Card Readers (positive fortune), RC Car Racing, and Students vs. Teachers/Admin games.
