

College Planning Checklist

- The Shawsheen Tech Guidance Office created a document for students: [Senior College Planning Checklist](#) as a tool to help them complete the steps required to apply to college.
- Students who plan to apply to a 4-year college, should review the document and reach out to their counselor if they have any questions or need clarification.
- Counselors will be visiting students in Related to give a general overview of the college application process but a 1-1 appointment with their counselor is recommended, especially if they plan to apply to college with an “Early Action” deadline (typically on or around November 1st).

 - Ask the teacher *in-person* at least 4 weeks before your first deadline
 - Only ask for as many letters as you need
 - Give a [Letter of Recommendation Form](#) to anyone writing you a letter
 - Be sure to give a copy to your guidance counselor
 - Click the link to learn how to [Submit Letter of Recommendation Request Through Naviance](#) so your teacher can upload their letter to your account
- **Submit a [Transcript Release Form](#)**
 - Give to your counselor 2 weeks before your 1st admissions deadline


College and Career Night
