
Shawsheen Title I Parent Meeting

Title I has three primary objectives:

- Improve student achievement for all participants
- Improve staff development
- Improve parental and community involvement

How are Title I funds distributed to districts?

Based on the number of low-income families in the district

Once a school qualifies for Title I, academic need, not income status determines which students receive services

The entire student body will benefit from title 1 funding.






SHAWSHEEN VALLEY TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL 2022-2023 SCHOOL-PARENT COMPACT

Recognizing that parents, faculty, and students share in the responsibility for improved student achievement, all stakeholders agree to the following:

- 1. Shawsheen Valley Technical High School will provide high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment.
- 2. Parents will support their children's learning by monitoring attendance, homework completion, and use of extracurricular time and by participating in decisions relating to the education of their children.
- 3. The student will participate in the classroom instruction, complete homework as assigned, and communicate needs to staff and parents as appropriate to enable him/her to make satisfactory progress toward attaining academic standards.
- 4. To facilitate communication between home and school, the school will conduct a parent-teacher open house and parent-teacher conferences to discuss student progress. An annual fall Title I orientation meeting will be held at prior to the first parent-teacher conference.
- 5. School-wide mid-term and quarterly grade reports will be provided through the Aspen Family Portal and teacher email addresses will be provided to further enhance communications between home and school.
- 6. Teachers will provide regular feedback to parents of students who are failing, of which parents are asked to review and then communicate questions/concern to teachers regarding student progress.
- 7. Parents unable to attend the two Parent Teacher Nights are invited to schedule individual meetings with teachers at a more convenient time to discuss their child's progress.
- 8. Shawsheen Valley Technical High School will provide parents with information in a language and form they can understand. To facilitate this, parents will inform the school of preferred language used in the home, if it is not English.
- 9. Shawsheen Valley Technical High School will provide parents with resources and information to assist them in supporting their child to succeed in school.
