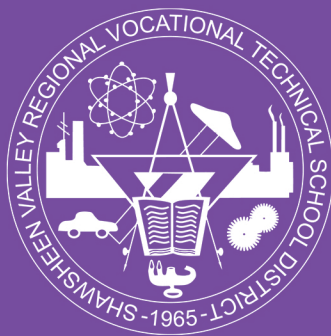

BEGINNER DRAWING (Ages 5-7)

BASEBALL CLINIC (Ages 7-15)
